Scattered thunderstorms are likely across parts of the Lower Mid-Missouri Valley during the late afternoon and evening. Very large hail, damaging wind gusts, and a few tornadoes are possible.

The Storm Prediction Center in Norman, Oklahoma has placed the Wichita area under an Enhanced risk for severe thunderstorms. These storms could contain very large hail between 1 to 2 inches in diameter, damaging wind gusts, and heavy rain.
